Code of Conduct

I will:

- Respect all involved with the program: coaches, wrestlers, and other members of the Poynette Panthers
- Respect the property of others
- Address coaches and other adults properly as instructed
- Listen when a coach is speaking and not cause distractions
- Attend practices consistently
- Stay in the wrestling room/gym until coach calls for break or excuses the group from practice
- Practice safety by not participating in horseplay
- Use positive language on or off the mat, even when things aren't going my way
- Practice good sportsmanship at all times as I am representing Poynette AND the sport of wrestling
- Do not bring food into the wrestling room/gym during practice times; and
- Strive to make good healthy diet and exercise choices outside of and at sponsored events.

I will remember the above statements and be proud of the Poynette Panther Youth Wrestling Club.

- If a member has an issue with another member of the Club s/he is to bring that matter to the attention of a Director by private conversation.
- As with Poynette Public Schools' athletic policy: the use/abuse of illegal/prescription and/or over the counter medications (OTC), consumption of alcohol, use of tobacco and its byproducts, at any time will not be tolerated.
- Adults need to refrain from use of alcohol and tobacco byproducts when on any school property as Wisconsin Law mandates.

Disciplinary action will be taken if any of the above offences occur:

Youth Member

- 1st Offense - Sit out for a portion of practice
- 2nd Offense - Coach has conference with parents
- 3rd Offense - Suspension from practice
- 4th Offense - Suspension from Club for season

Adult Member

- 1st Offense - Be addressed by Director or Coach
- 2nd Offense - Asked to leave event
- 3rd Offense - Limited Club involvement
- 4th Offense - Suspension from Club for season
